Communicating with your Dog

Did you know that dogs can talk? They can!

Oftentimes, we just don't know how to listen. I'm Veronica, an Easthambased dog trainer, and I can teach you how to talk to your dog in a way s/he understands, and I can teach you how to listen.

Good dog training bridges the communication gap between human and canine. Dogs are not robots; they are highly intelligent, complex, emotional, perceptive creatures, and helping them live in our manmade world is much easier once we grasp this concept.

First we build a foundation of trust, communication, and understanding, and then we apply this to real-world scenarios to find harmony in our life with our dogs. Play and other instinctual, biologically fulfilling activities play a vital role in my training - fear, intimidation, and boring obedience drills do not. Training should be fun for both dog and human. All training plans are highly tailored to individual needs, goals, and learning styles.

Here are some things we can work on together: Leash walking

- Off-leash reliability (yes, I promise it's possible!)
- Trail skills
- Reactivity/barking/lunging/jumping
- House manners, manners in public .
- Puppy raising ٠
- fear/confidence building

Basic obedience - sit, down, stay, heel, dog sports - nosework, canicross, joring, mountain biking, and more
